July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009**

Free Meals – 130 Percent

Reduced Price Meal – 185 Percent

Reminders

- \*Multiply income that is received every 2 weeks (biweekly) by 26 to arrive at annual income or by 2.15 to arrive at monthly income.
- \*Multiply weekly income by 52 to arrive at annual income or by 4.33 to arrive at monthly income.
- \*Gross or total income must be used in determining eligibility for wage earners.
- \*A net lost from a business or farm may not be used to offset other income.
