


Welcome to EBSCO’s Basic Searching on EBSCOhost tutorial. In this tutorial, we will look at conducting a search from the Basic Search screen of EBSCOhost.

We’ll begin by conducting a Basic Search on *global warming*. Enter your search terms and click **Search**. Or you can view available limiters and expanders by clicking on **Search Options**.

Under the **Search Options**, it is easy to limit or expand your search results. You can choose from one of the available Search Modes and depending upon the databases you have chosen, you may see the ability to limit a search by Full Text articles, Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals, or a particular publication that you enter in the field provided. After applying limiters and expanders, click **Search**.
