First and foremost, these resources provide information from the Encyclopedia Britannica. Britannica Online also gives users access to dictionaries and thesauruses, and newsfeeds from the BBC and New York Times, Year in Review, Animal Kingdom, Britannica Learning Zone, and more.

Each edition of Encyclopedia Britannica contains a video collection, blogs, timelines, daily updates from age-appropriate newspapers, spotlights on history and biography, a guided tour of the database and excellent help pages. Whatever your age, education level, or interest, the relevant information you need can be found in Britannica Online.
