You can use any style of flash drive, as long as they are not larger than 4 gigabytes.

Digital books on BARD are available in a “Zip” or compressed file. You first need to download the book to your computer. Afterwards, you can “Unzip” it and then transfer it your flash drive.

You do not want to download or move a Zipped file onto your flash drive, the talking book machine will not be able to read it. Likewise, you want to dedicate the flash drive that you are using to BARD books only, do not use this flash drives for pictures, music files, video files, documents, etc. Any other files on the flash drive will cause problems for the talking book machine trying to read the downloaded book files.

BARD books cannot be played on standard audio equipment or your computer, the downloads are encrypted and can only be played on NLS Digital Talking Book Machine or compatible devices.

If you want to load multiple books on to your flash-drive, you must create a folder for each separate book on your flash-drive.






If you are going to download a lot of books and magazines, I suggest you create a folder in Documents to save your downloaded files.

Downloading a file may take several minutes, depending on the length of the book and the speed of your internet connection. Allow the file to completely download.




The file you just downloaded will be zipped or compressed. You will need to unzip or extract it.


Next, you'll need to Unzip or extract the files. I'm using a computer with Windows 7 as its operating system. Different operating systems use different programs to unzip or extract files. If you have never unzipped a file before, consult your computer manual or use Google for lookup information on how to unzip file using the operating system installed on your computer.

To unzip this file, I will put the cursor on the zipped title, click the left button on the mouse once to highlight it, and then, click the right button once to open a menu.





Once the menu is open, select Extract All to unzip the file. Different operating systems use different programs to unzip or extract files. If you have never unzipped a file before, consult your computer manual or use Google for information on how to unzip file using the operating system installed on your computer.

You can extract or unzip your BARD downloaded book directly into your Flash Drive by selecting a destination and choosing the flash drive in the menu. Using Windows 7, click “Browse” for selecting a destination.





Now you are ready to load the unzipped digital talking book onto your flash drive!
Stick you Flash Drive into your computer.





To find your Flash Drive, select “Computer” and then select “Removable Disk.”





“Removable Disk” may be called by another name, depending on the brand of Flash Drive.





By clicking “Next” the extract file will be loaded onto your Flash Drive.

Remember, if you want to load more than one book on your flash-drive, Create a folder for each book. That way the talking book machine will read only one book at a time.

On the side of your talking book machine, there is a USB port. Insert your flash drive into the machine. Your downloaded book will play just like one of the cartridge books. You can use all of the functions, such as fast forward, reverse, etc., on your machine with your downloaded book as well.

If you load multiple books on your flash-drive, you can use the book shelf feature on your talking book machine. To use the Book Shelf, hold down the play button until you hear the bookshelf mode.



Release the play button and use the arrow buttons to move between the books loaded on your flash-drive. When you hear the title you want to read, press the play button and the book will start playing.
