Electric Library is an easy to use general reference tool which offers a broad range of full-text and multimedia content for people of all ages.

What does eLibrary offer?

- ◆ Easy use and navigation.
- ◆ Full-text articles.
- ◆ Viewing, printing, or e-mailing of any document or image.
- ◆ Reliable, age-appropriate reference material.
- ◆ Simple searching — just ask a question.
- ◆ Searching of different media formats simultaneously.
- ◆ Access to ethnic, international, and small press publications.
- ◆ Searching by author, title, keyword, and reading level.
- ◆ Results by relevancy, date, size, reading level, title, or publication.

eLibrary

Offers a broad range of full-text and multimedia content for people of all ages.



Newspapers

Includes over 250 national and international newspapers, including *USA Today*, *Toronto Star*, and *Xinhua News Agency*.



Magazines

Over 1,600 magazines offered, such as *Jack and Jill*, *Life*, and *Money*.



Books

A full collection of reference books, including *Great Works of Literature*, *Webster's New World Thesaurus*, and *American Heritage Dictionary*.



Pictures

Access to digital images through *Archive Photos*, *Getty Images*, *NOAA Photo Library*, and many more.



Maps
