Digital Magazines Are Coming

Starting on February 16, the digital magazines from RBdigital will be available on the Libby app through OverDrive.

Over 3,000 titles, including National Geographic, Good Housekeeping, Rolling Stone, and Vanity Fair, will be available with unlimited simultaneous use (no waitlists or holds). At the end of the checkout period, the magazines will be automatically returned, but you can check them out again right away.

Users will need to have an active library card and a PIN - if you are using a State Library card, your PIN is your last name, all lowercase.
