












#### **New Nonfiction E-Audiobooks**


Our family has a love for kid's audiobooks! Here are two that we recently enjoyed.

The Genius Files is a five-book series by Dan Gutman about a family with super smart 12-year old twins, Pepsi and Coke, who take an exciting cross-country vacation across the United States. The family uses a Rand McNally road atlas and references Google maps to help the reader follow along on the trip. The stories are filled with fun facts and history about America, along with descriptions of a few weird-buttrue tourist attractions along the way. However, with adults always trying to assassinate the twins, and the twins injuring or killing adults in self-defense, this five-book series might not be appropriate for all kids.

Rafe starts 6th grade by trying to break every rule in the school's Code of Conduct handbook! James Patterson's *Middle School* series focuses on the problems that kids face during their middle school years at both school and home. There are crushes, bullying, family problems, and Rafe's biggest pain, his younger sister Georgia!
