The Interlibrary Loan Department will be changing the method we use to track interlibrary loan statistics. Beginning on July 1, 2021, we will discontinue tracking interlibrary loan stats by individual library. Therefore, libraries will need to keep track of their own interlibrary loan statistics for annual reporting purposes.
