#### **Library Vision Grants Webinar**

The North Dakota State Library held three webinars last week to review the grant application process for the upcoming Library Vision Grants. These presentations reviewed the steps needed to fill out the grant, discussed the eligible and ineligible expenses and other details. 

#### **Compare ND and National Library Data**

The Census has developed a <u>new dashboard</u> in coordination with the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) that combines FY19 Annual Report data with the 2015–2019 American Community Survey Data.

By interacting with the layers, users can drill down to public library building location and statistics at the county level. Scrolling through the panels on the sides allow you to view statistics for each state, in many cases normalized per person for better comparison across states (left side), or view all the library systems within a state and click on a link to imls.gov to access downloadable PDFs (right side).

#### **KitKeeper**

Are you new to using KitKeeper to order kits from the North Dakota State Library? KitKeeper is an online reservation system that you can use to reserve book club kits and the STEM, STEAM, Fairytale and Folktale kits, NASA@ My Library kits, Outdoor Exploration kits, etc. The State Library's KitKeeper Basics tutorial, found in Niche Academy, will walk you through how to find and reserve kits. 




