7/1/2013 – 6/30/2014 School Year – Dispute Resolution Summary

Five requests for FIEP were received –

- Two of the five facilitations resulted in successful completion of the IEP.
- The other three requests did not result in facilitations due to the other party not wishing to proceed with facilitation.

Two requests for Mediation were received –

- One mediation request was received but the other party chose not to mediate.
- The other mediation meeting resulted in no agreement.

Three requests for Complaint Investigations were received –

- Of the three separate requests for complaint investigations, one was fully investigated.

Four requests for Due Process were received –

- Request #1 – The request was submitted to OAH at the end of this Fiscal year; the outcome will be reported in the 2014-2015 Federal reporting period.
- Request #2 – The Resolution Meeting resulted in parties requesting a deadline extension for 90 days that extended into the next reporting period; the outcome will be reported in the 2014-2015 Federal reporting period.
- Request #3 – The District withdrew its request for a Due Process Complaint.
- Request #4 – No agreement was reached by parties in one Resolution meeting. Parties agreed to cancel the Due Process Pre-hearing on 11//22, and Hearing on 11/25/2013. Facilitated IEP Meetings were held on 12/17/13 and 5/22/2014.
