


# Dakota Radio Information Service (DRIS)

## Dakota Radio Information Service (DRIS)

**DRIS** is a radio broadcast for persons with print impairments. This broadcast is available 24 hours a day for persons living in the western two-thirds of North Dakota. **DRIS** began broadcasting March 5, 1984, in Bismarck and has expanded to Minot, Williston, Dickinson, Jamestown, Valley City, and their surrounding areas. The local news is read *live* each weekday and is repeated in the evening.
