



What are E-Books?

- E-Books are electronic versions of books.
- E-Books are unabridged and complete, and include graphics and photographs.

Why Use E-Books?

- E-Books allow easy searching so specific information can be located quickly.
- E-Books are great for using as additional references or last minute research.
- E-Books allow the user to electronically add notes.
- E-Books' tables of contents are hyperlinked and completely searchable.



Accessing E-Books

- Register at your school or public library, or call the North Dakota State Library at 1-800-472-2104 or (701) 328-4622.
- No charge to register.
- Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- E-Books focus on social science, humanities, literature, computer science, agriculture, and general science.
- More than 8,000 titles available for loan.
- Search by full-text, keyword, title, author, publisher, subject, and ISBN.
