#### Beep! Beep!

Have you ever wondered how the bookmobile came about? According to *The whole library handbook 5* edited by George M. Eberhart, the first iteration of a bookmobile was a book wagon introduced in Maryland in 1905. Mary L. Titcomb, the first librarian at the Washington County Free Library, had the idea to take the books to the county residents instead of expecting them to come to the library. She was confident that this service would cement a friendship with the library, that the roads in the county were good and the cost of upkeeping the wagon would not be too expensive. That book wagon made its first trip in April 1905.

According to 2024 data, North Dakota has 11 bookmobiles and Ward County Public Library has won the Wheelie award for 2025. How cool is it that books can come right to you if you're lucky enough to have bookmobile service in your area?!
