Your library has access to a wealth of information in the form of online library resources. Mango is only available for patrons of public libraries and the State Library. If you are a school or academic library, your patrons will need a library card from their local public library or the State Library.

Description

Mango provides your patrons an opportunity to learn over 60 languages, including Spanish, German, and Norwegian, along with courses for non-English speakers to learn English.


Each course immerses users in real-world situations using native speaker audio and includes a voice comparison feature to help you nail the pitch-perfect accent. Memory-building exercises strengthen critical thinking skills and empower you to break down words and sentences to build new phrases on your own.

Mango is also available as an app for your mobile devices.


