

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I reserve a kit?

Kits can be reserved through the online library catalog at <https://polaris.odinlibrary.org/polaris/>.

How long can I keep a kit?

All kits have a loan period of 8 weeks.

How much does it cost?

You are responsible for the cost of sending the kit back to the State Library. Shipping costs depend on which kit you reserve.

If you lose or damage a kit component, you will be charged accordingly.

How many kits can I check out?

There is a limit of three kits at a time without prior approval.

I'm a teacher. How do I check out a kit?

Reservations for schools must be made by the School Media Specialist.
