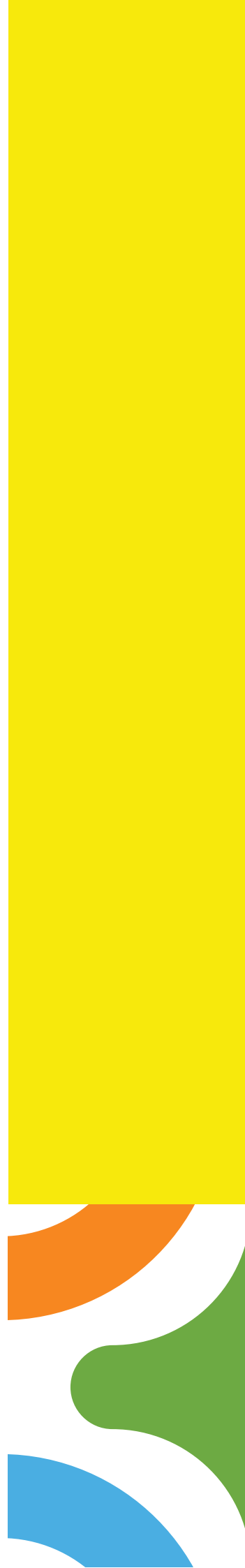


Online Library Resource Guide

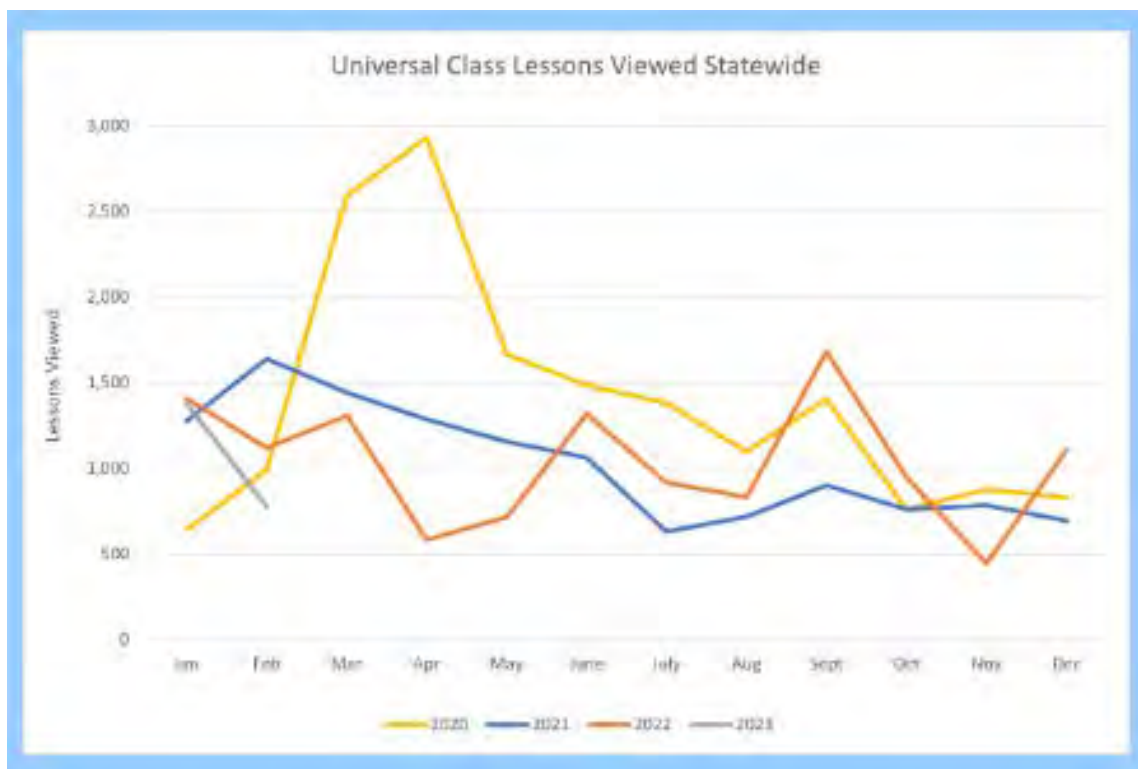
Description

Universal Class provides your patrons an opportunity to learn skills and hobbies through free online continuing education courses. With over 500 courses in 30 areas of study available, there is something for everyone. The areas of study include career training, crafts and hobbies, homeschooling, do-it-yourself, personal development, office skills, special education, teacher resources, test preparation, and web development.

These online courses can be completed at your own pace, and many of them have an audit option, which allows you to attend the class without having to take the tests or complete the assignments. If you choose the audit option, you will not get the continuing education credit(s) or the certificate at the end.
