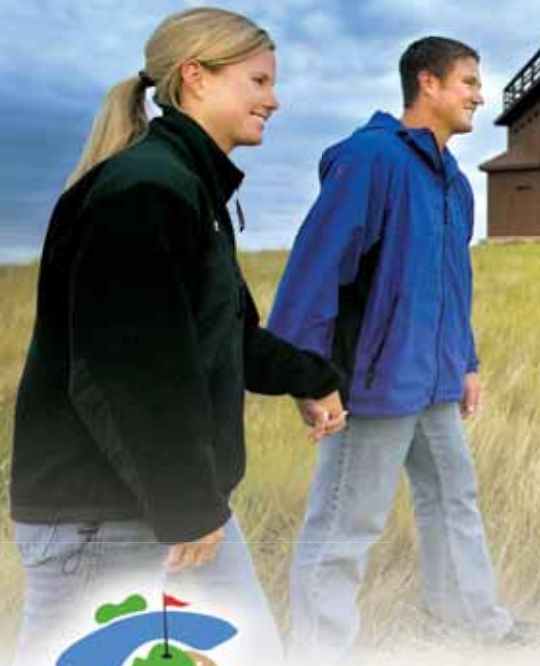

Ten Sites to Visit along the Historic Lewis & Clark Golf Trail

As golfers play the Lewis & Clark Golf Trail's many courses, they can tee-off along the Missouri River where Captain Meriwether Lewis admired the scenery, walk fairways where the Lewis & Clark Expedition hunted buffalo or elk, and relax for refreshments where Sakakawea helped the expedition prepare a meal.

Time spent on the Lewis & Clark Golf Trail blends the state's premiere golf courses with its many legendary attractions. After a round of golf, many historic sites are within driving distance of the courses and allow visitors to enjoy the rich history of the state. Below are highlights of 10 sites to visit along the Lewis & Clark Golf Trail.

1. Huff Indian Village

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Huff Indian Village preserves a large prehistoric village occupied by the Mandan Indians around 1450. The village, located one-half mile south of Huff, is estimated to have been home to a thousand or more people, and its community layout is easily seen on the surface. Depressions marking the locations of more than 100 lodges are arranged roughly in rows, paralleling the river bank. The village, including its fortifications, covers about 12 acres. Interpretive signage allows visitors to enjoy a self-guided tour. Additional information is available by visiting www.history.nd.gov or by calling 701-328-2666.

2. Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park and Mandan Indian On-A-Slant Village

South of Mandan on ND Highway 1806, Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park includes reconstructed blockhouses, the Custer House and Native American earthlodges. Lt. Col. George Custer and the 7th Cavalry were stationed at the site before the Battle

of Little Bighorn, and earthlodges depict the lifestyle of the Mandan Indians, who first occupied the site from about 1575-1781. Visitors can tour Custer's home and barracks, enjoy lively interpretations of Army life and explore the Mandan Indian Village, the birthplace of Chief Sheheke. 3. Lewis & Clark Riverboat

Located in the Port of Bismarck, visitors can cruise the majestic Missouri River between Bismarck and Mandan on the Lewis & Clark Riverboat. Passengers enjoy the view of the river as Lewis and Clark would have seen it from their keelboat and enjoy a narrated tour. The Riverboat is available for daily public cruises, dinner cruises and special events, and food and beverages are also available. Visit www.lewisandclarkriverboat.com or call 701-255-4233 for more information.

4. Double Ditch Indian Village

Located seven miles north of Bismarck on ND Highway 1804, the Double Ditch Indian Village site contains the ruins of a large Mandan Indian earthlodge village inhabited during the period of 1500-1781. Double Ditch was one of seven to nine villages simultaneously occupied near the mouth of the Heart River, and the earthlodge villages were centers of trade. The remains of earthlodges, refuse mounds and the two surrounding fortification ditches are clearly discernible, and visitors can enjoy a self-guided tour of the site. 5. Cross Ranch State Park

Located near Washburn along seven miles of the last free-flowing, undeveloped stretches of the Missouri River, Cross Ranch State Park has been purposely left primitive to preserve

the land's natural beauty. An extensive trail system can be explored either on foot or on cross country skis during the winter months. During the summer, trails also allow access to a 5,000-acre dedicated nature preserve where mixed grass prairie, river bottom forests and woody draws can be seen. The River Peoples Visitor Center displays information about the mighty Missouri River, and visitors can stay in one of the park's campgrounds, cabins or yurts. 6. Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center and Fort Mandan

Located near Washburn on US Highway 83, both sites are considered must-sees on the Lewis & Clark National Historic Trail. The newly-remodeled Interpretive Center has state-of-the-art interactive exhibits about the Lewis & Clark Expedition, the story of Fort Clark and the early fur trade. The reconstructed Fort Mandan takes visitors back in time to the winter home of the Lewis & Clark Expedition from 1804-1805. The fully-furnished quarters bring to life what it was like for the brave men in the Corps of Discovery during that North Dakota winter more than 200 years ago. 7. Garrison Dam

Located near Riverdale, free one- to two-hour tours are available of the Garrison Power Plant and the operation and functions of the dam, along with explanations on the electric distribution of power. Visitors can also experience Lake Sakakawea, the third-largest manmade lake in the United States, held back by the Garrison Dam. The lake is 178 miles long, has more than 1,500 miles of shoreline, and is a recreational destination for anglers, boaters and campers. 8. Fort Stevenson State Park

On the north shore of Lake Sakakawea and three miles south of Garrison, Fort Stevenson State Park is known as the walleye capital of North Dakota. The park is home to the Governor's Cup Walleye Tournament as well as two marinas. Visitors will also find a modern campground, sleeping cabins, visitor center, interpretive trails and prairie dog town. Fort Stevenson State Park also features the Guardhouse Museum where visitors can learn the post's history. Additional information is available at www.parkrec.nd.gov or by calling 701-337-5576.

9. Missouri-Yellowstone Confluence Interpretive Center

Located one-half mile east of Fort Buford, the Missouri-Yellowstone Confluence Interpretive Center tells the story of the confluence of the Yellowstone and Missouri Rivers, as well as provides the same magnificent view that Lewis & Clark Expedition members enjoyed when they visited in 1805 and 1806. The rotunda area includes three large murals featuring quotes from the Lewis & Clark Journals and paintings of the Missouri River landscape. Visitors can also stop at the nearby Fort Buford State Historic Site. For additional information, visit www.history.nd.gov or call 701-572-9034.

10. Fort Union Trading Post National Historic Site

Located near Williston, the Fort Union Trading Post National Historic Site served as the principal fur trading post of the American Fur Company on the upper Missouri River in the 1800s. Here, the Assiniboine and six other Northern Plains Indian Tribes exchanged buffalo robes and smaller furs for goods from around the world. The Fort includes the Bourgeois House/Visitor Center with exhibits and close-captioned videos that document Fort Union's life and history. A reconstructed Trade House is also furnished to look as it did in the early 1850s. Additional information is available at www.nps.gov or by calling 701-572-9083.

THE LINKS OF NORTH DAKOTA presents players with an exceptional golfing experience reminiscent of great Scottish links courses.

This nationally recognized layout on the bluffs overlooking Lake Sakakawea gives players of any ability a chance to test all facets of their game. Water isn't a factor on this par 72 championship course, which plays anywhere from 5,249 yards to 7,092 yards, but 85+ sand bunkers are. Depending on the time of day or year, wind can also be expected to be a factor in your game here.

Players have the option of five tee boxes to choose from as they set out for 18 holes of links-style golf on a course with wide-open fairways but punishing native prairie grass rough.

Architect Stephen Kay moved a minimal amount of dirt in placing this course on the rolling land overlooking the big lake, and you can expect some uneven lies as you navigate this world-class venue.

Pro shop, snack and beverage service, club rental, driving range, practice greens, PGA pro, lessons, and cart rental are all available.

MEDICINE HOLE GOLF COURSE is the newest golf course on the trail, featuring a wide-open vista with native grass rough. It also provides a spectacular view of the Killdeer Mountains and Battlefield, and the surrounding area, from the first tee.

The course, named after a cave in the nearby Killdeer Mountains, is a 9-hole track that measures 3,290 yards from the black tees or 6,580 yards for 18 holes. Award-winning architect Jim Engh, who designed Bismarck's Hawktree, used the natural terrain to give golfers changes in elevation ranging from 12 feet to 120 feet.

Water and out-of-bounds will be in play on the par 4 second hole, and water will be in play on the par 3 fifth hole.

Golf professional, pro shop, snack bar, practice range, lessons, golf cart rental, pull carts, and club rental are all available.

BLACK SANDS GOLF COURSE of Beulah is located on the south side of Lake Sakakawea, in North Dakota's energy producing country, and takes its name from the black coal slag in the bunkers, similar to that found in the bunkers at Bismarck's Hawktree.

Play this 9-hole course twice, and it measures 6,226 yards and plays to a par 70.

You'll find water hazards on four holes, and grass bunkers to test your short game skills, as well as some changes in elevation.

That hole is a par 3 that measures 200 yards from the back tee to a severely crowned green.

The course measures 5,842 yards for 18 and plays to a par 70 for men. Women play to a par 72 over 4,952 yards.

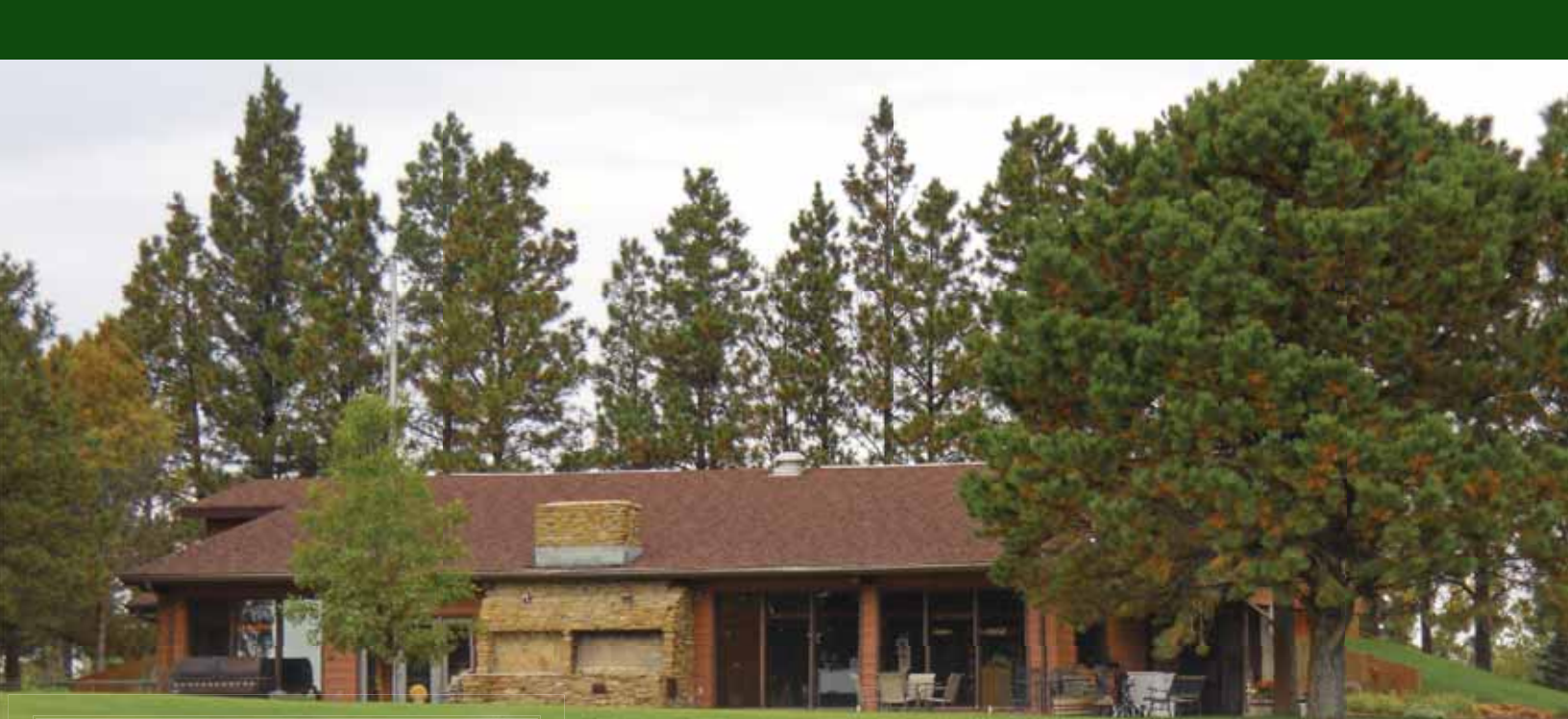

The Links of North Dakota (The Links), set on the picturesque bluffs of Lake Sakakawea, provides an ideal and unforgettable golf experience. "More than anything, it is truly a links golf course," says Jeff Covington, PGA head professional. "It is like nothing around in the region."

The Links, located just 28 miles from Williston and 16 miles from Ray in the heart of the area's Bakken Oil Formation, is recognized as one of the purest

examples of links-style golf ever built in the United States. Designed by architect Stephen Kay and opened in 1995, the course's true links fashion challenges golfers of all levels. "We believe we have some of the best conditions in the state with Bent grass on all of our fairways, tees and greens," notes Covington. "There is also no water on the course, but the lake is visible from every hole so the views are spectacular."

Players have the option of five tee boxes at each of the

18 holes with wide open fairways and native prairie grass rough. More than 80 sand bunkers and wind also factor into rounds at The Links. The course hosted more than 9,000 rounds of golf in 2015 and will host the 2016 State Stroke Play Championships.

The Links has been recognized in the list of Top 100 Golf Courses by both *Golfweek* and *Golf Digest* magazines. "The layout of the course is exceptional and we have some of the purest fairways and greens," says Covington. "How they roll and react to the ball is what you would expect from a championship golf course."

"Stay-and-Play" options are offered on-site with 20 year-round RV spots and 12 cabins on the course's property.

"It is a true links-style golf course, which you don't find too often in the United States, let alone North Dakota," says Covington. "This will be a stop people will want to continue to make."

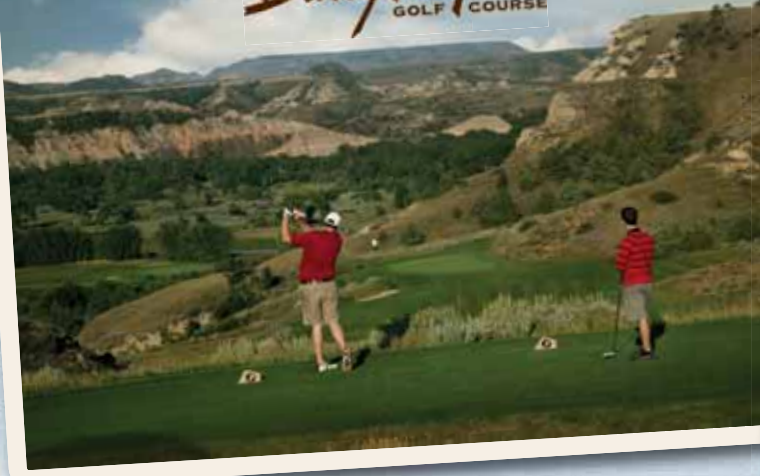
Historic Medora's championship Bully Pulpit Golf Course was named in the spirit of President Theodore Roosevelt. "This is the ultimate bucket lister as far as golf goes," says Casey Moen, PGA head golf professional. "We see golfers from across the United States and the world coming here to play."

Moen notes the course was designed by Dr. Michael Hurdzan, who has stated, "Although I have seen thousands of potential golf course sites, this one near Medora, North Dakota, may be the best I have seen without ocean views."

The course experienced a record-setting year in only its 12th golfing season, with nearly 19,400 rounds of

golf played in 2015. “Bully Pulpit is a world-class golfing experience and the word is definitely getting out about the course,” says Moen.

Players have the opportunity to see the area’s scenery, from the Little Missouri River bottoms to the elevation changes and dramatic setting of the Badlands. “We call it the crescendo effect, you start not knowing what to expect but the excitement just builds and builds as you reach the Badlands holes in the back nine,” says Moen.

Bully Pulpit has been named to the list of the Top 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses, Top 10 Courses You Can Play, Top 50 America’s Most Fun Courses and America’s Best New Affordable Public Course in 2006. Moen says the course recently got a “rustic” facelift of its on-course accessories, renovated its driving range and built a new starter shack at the first hole. In addition, the course updated its entire fleet of golf carts and will soon be updating all cart paths.

“Not only are we a golf course, but we are also part of the number one tourist attraction in North Dakota, the town of Medora,” says Moen, adding Bully Pulpit is also close to Theodore Roosevelt National Park. “The National Park System is celebrating 100 years in 2016 and Medora is the gateway to the national park.”

The Vardon Golf Club

Opened in 1929 as the Minot Country Club, the Vardon Golf Club was completely rebuilt, rededicated and reopened in August 2013 after being inundated by the 2011 Souris River flood. “It was quite a challenge starting from a place that was pretty beat up by the flood, but we keep trying to make it better every year,” says Todd Lee, head golf professional. “It’s a golf course that is very playable for everybody.”

The course hosts 13,000 rounds annually and has been a major stop on the Dakota Professional Golf Tour for more than three decades. The Vardon’s 18 holes are not long in distance, but are defended by quick greens that require an accurate approach. “One of the course’s strongest features has always been the greens,” says Lee. “They are always in excellent shape.”

The course is built in the valley west of Minot, and Lee says it has a traditional layout, reminiscent of old-style courses. “It is very easy to walk or ride, and is very accessible for players from five to 95 years old.”

He says many golfers look forward to returning to play the course each year. “You’ll be happy you played The Vardon. It’s a great course and it’s just going to get better as it continues to mature.”

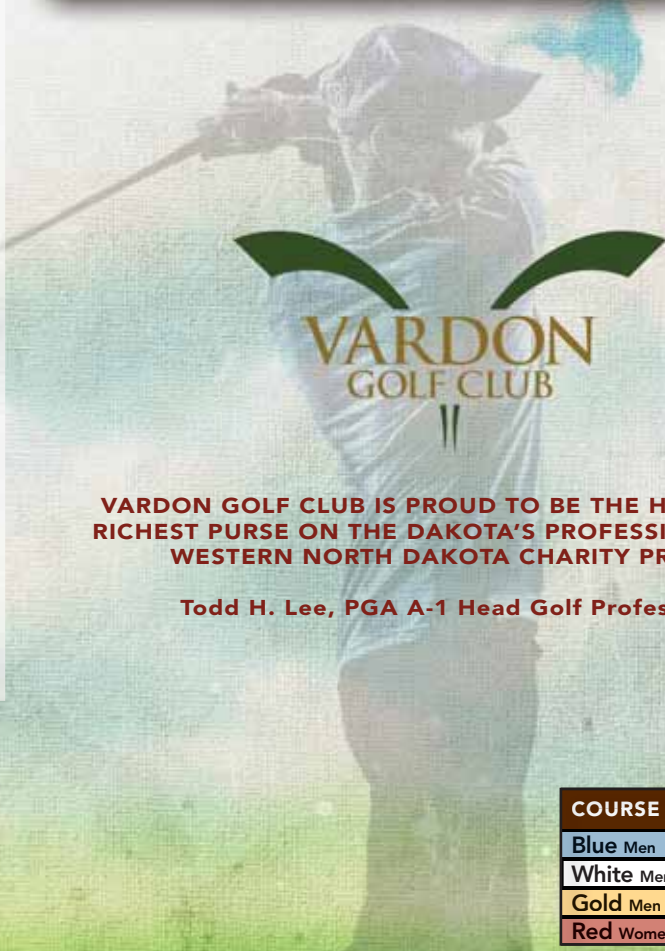

GHIN and NDGA Membership

GHIN (Golf Handicap Index Number) revenue is the lifeblood of every State and Regional Golf Association. This revenue is used to operate the association, to provide a golf course rating team, to promote the game of golf across the state, to assist in tournament operations, to exist as the authority on the Rules of Golf in the State, and to promote and develop junior golf.

The staff at the NDGA and the Board of Directors recommend that every player establish a handicap whether they are playing in a tournament or a casual game with friends. The USGA is the only body that can issue a recognized Handicap Index to play in sanctioned events. Also, if you are playing in fundraising events it is our recommendation that each player carries a handicap to legitimize the competition, to level the playing field, and to responsibly compete in all events.

A GHIN does the following:

1. Levels the playing field – allows golfers of differing abilities to play a fair and competitive round or competition with other golfers of differing skills and gender and from different tees. No other online program can accomplish what the GHIN system can.
2. Legitimizes competitions across all USGA GHIN member courses across the world. Where ever a golfer travels to play golf at a USGA licensed golf facility – your GHIN number travels with you and you can fairly compete within the guidelines of the State and National GHIN system.
3. Your GHIN membership provides for the promotion of your local club, has given over \$60,000 in grants to Junior Golf across the state.
4. The USGA asks all golfers to do their part and play fairly under the Rules of Golf – Your GHIN is an essential component to fair competition.

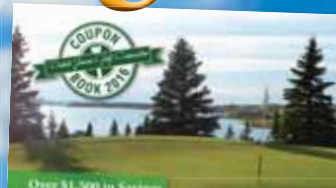

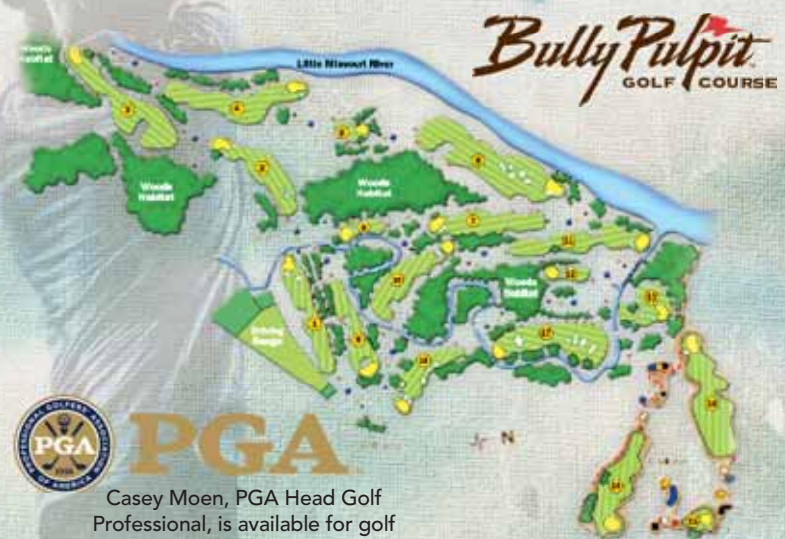

Pro shop, dining area, driving range, cart rental, and practice areas for chipping, putting, and bunker play are available.

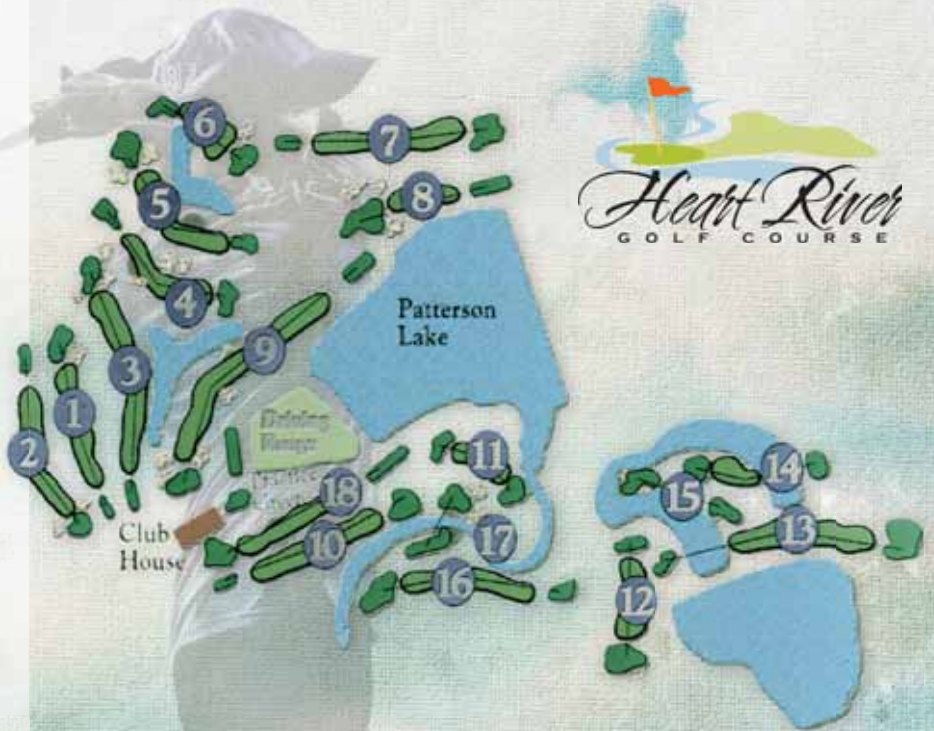
