## WHERE TO FISH

While it helps for you to bring a fish finder and your good, old-fashioned know-how to locate the fish, we can get you started with directions to a few of our hot fisheries. Some of the major fishing waters in the state are what we call the "big three," Devils Lake, Lake Sakakawea and The Missouri River including northern Lake Oahe.

#### **DEVILS LAKE**

The state's largest natural body of water has several resorts, campgrounds and the Spirit Lake Casino. You'll find excellent ice fishing for perch, walleye and northern pike in the winter and walleye, pike and white bass in the open water.

#### LAKE SAKAKAWEA

This amazing 479-square-mile reservoir — famous for its walleye, northern pike and Chinook salmon — has numerous bays surrounded by cut banks and badlands bluffs. It offers dozens of public boat ramps and several marinas.

### **MISSOURI RIVER INCLUDING LAKE OAHE**

The free-flowing river offers a good setting for walleye in the spring and fall. The far northwestern reaches of the Missouri in North Dakota is one of the better spots in the country to snag a giant paddlefish in May. Lake Oahe stretches from southcentral North Dakota into South Dakota. Anglers can find walleye and northern pike in this area, but there are also crappie, catfish, sturgeon and white bass.

### GAME FISHING SEASON NEVER CLOSES

If you are one of those people who would be happy fishing every single day, then North Dakota presents a rare opportunity for you. You can fish 365 days of the year here if you choose. Just park your boat when the lakes freeze and bring out your ice house to jig for walleye, perch and bluegill — or try darkhouse spearfishing for northern pike. With licenses good for most species April 1 through March 31, there is always a whopper waiting whenever you are ready to drop a line.

## HOTSPOTS

North Dakota Game & Fish manages hundreds of fishing waters besides the big three. Large reservoirs with highly active fishing include Lake Darling, Lake Ashtabula, Jamestown Reservoir, Lake Tschida and Lake Audubon. Anglers can find some of the best fishing spots at locations in the right column:

### UPLAND GAME SEASONS

The seasons for sharp-tailed grouse and Hungarian partridge open in early September, with pheasant opening about one month later in early October. All three species' seasons run to approximately the beginning of the new year. Actual dates will be posted on the ND Game & Fish website.

### PHEASANT

Pheasant can be found statewide in North Dakota. Traditionally the highest concentration of birds have been found in the southwestern part of the state, though the northwest has seen higher bird counts and more stable populations in recent years.



### SHARP-TAILED GROUSE

Sharp-tailed grouse can be found statewide. Higher populations of grouse are found in the far western part of the state including the badlands.

### HUNGARIAN PARTRIDGE

Hungarian partridge's primary range is across western North Dakota and an area in central North Dakota between US Hwy 52 and I-94.

## WATERFOWL

North Dakota is home to the Central Flyway, a waterfowl superhighway for millions of migrating ducks and geese. Our rivers, lakes and wetlands stretch far and wide, offering premier waterfowl habitat. Come experience it for yourself and have the hunt of a lifetime.

### WATERFOWL SEASONS

North Dakota's waterfowl season kicks off with an early resident opener at the end of September. The regular waterfowl season opens to everyone typically in early October. Additional opportunities exist with an early season for Canada geese that opens in August and a spring season for snow geese that runs mid-February through mid-May. Official snow goose dates typically become available in August.

### DUCKS

Duck species are diverse in North Dakota. Altogether, hunters have a total daily limit of 6 ducks with specific limits on mallards, scaup, wood ducks, redheads, pintails, canvasbacks, blue-winged teal and mergansers. Possession limits



are three times the daily limits. Other species for hunting may include coots, wigeon, buffleheads, goldeneye, gadwalls, green-winged teal, northern shovelers, ring-necked ducks and ruddy ducks.

### CANADA GOOSE

The Canada goose is common to abundant during migration and nesting seasons in North Dakota. Some geese will winter along river systems where open water is available providing more opportunities to hunt waterfowl later in the season.

### SNOW GOOSE (SPRING LIGHT GOOSE)

Snows and blues are medium-sized geese measuring 25-31 inches from beak to tail and weighing 4-6.5 pounds. There are different color phases of the same species, and there is no daily limit nor is there a possession limit for snow geese in the spring season.

## WATERFOWL LICENSES

All hunters must possess a certificate, a general game & habitat license, a federal waterfowl stamp and HIP registration as a prerequisite.

## **ZONE RESTRICTED LICENSE**

There are three zones for nonresident waterfowlers to choose from. A nonresident must select one of the following:

> Zone 1 or Zone 2 for one 7-day period and Zone 3 for the other 7-day period

OR

Zone 3 for the full 14 days or two 7-day periods

Zones 1 and 3 concurrently for the same 7-day period or Zones 2 and 3 concurrently for the same 7-day period. (This option effectively reduces the license to seven days only, as the two 7-day periods are run at the same time.)

## BIG GAME & VARMINTS

Nonresidents may purchase whitetailed deer archery tags online. Bighorn sheep, deer gun and any deer archery tags are drawn by lottery open to nonresidents. Prairie dogs and coyotes may be hunted year-round with purchased nonresident tags.

## LAND ACCESS

There are hundreds of thousands of acres of prime habitat in PLOTS (Private Land Open To Sportsmen), wildlife management areas and waterfowl production areas open to public hunting. For pheasants, nonresidents may begin hunting on wildlife management areas and PLOTS land they do not own one week after the season opener.

No hunting is allowed without permission from the landowner or lessee on private lands that are legally posted either with physical signs or electronically. Unposted private lands (not physically or electronically posted) that are not otherwise restricted to hunting by law may be hunted without landowner permission.
